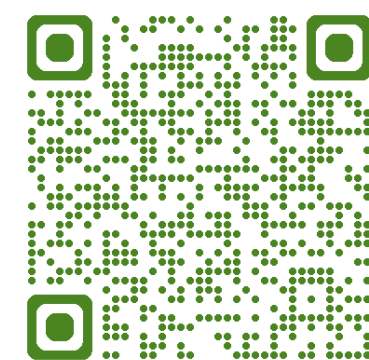

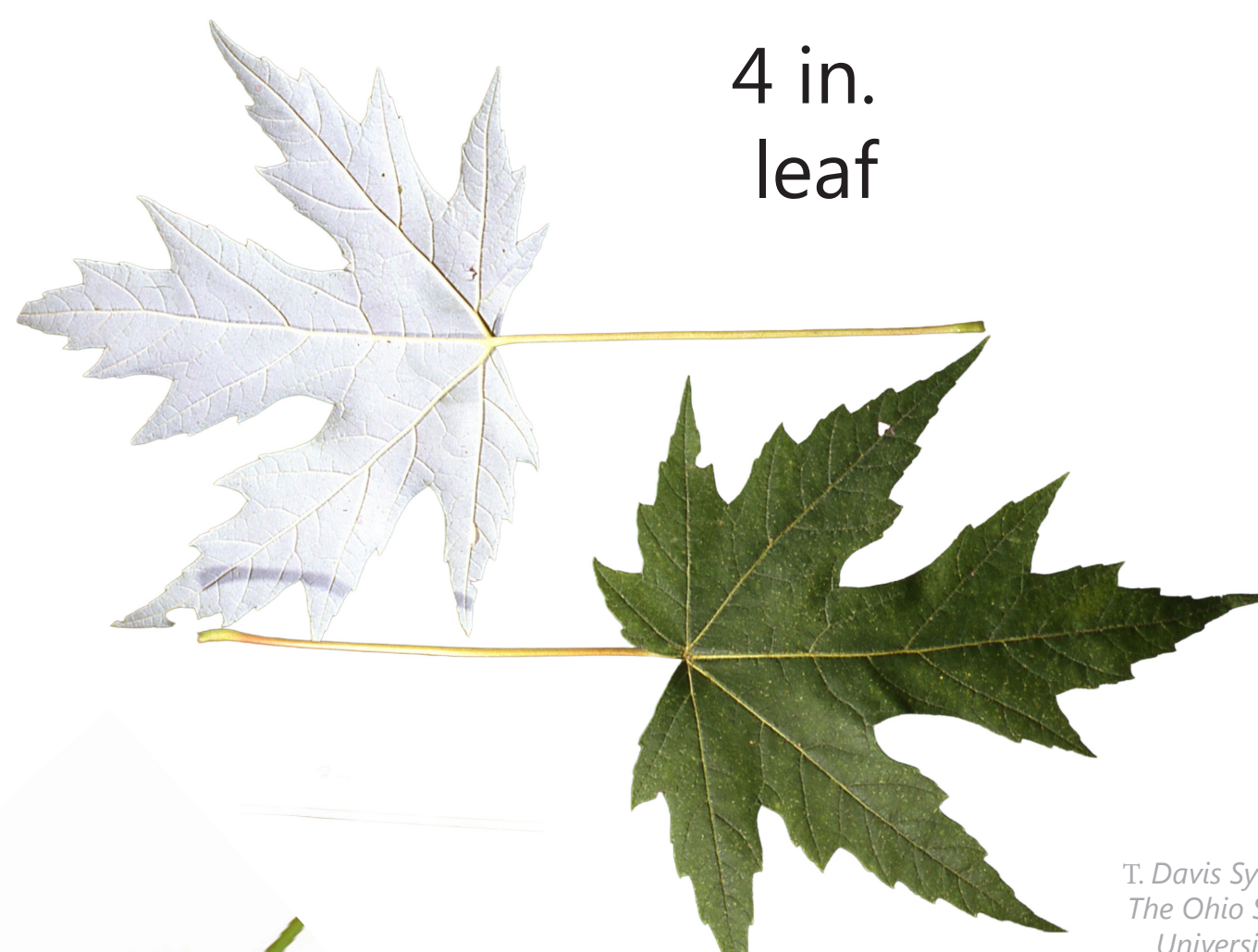
Scientific name: *Acer saccharinum*
