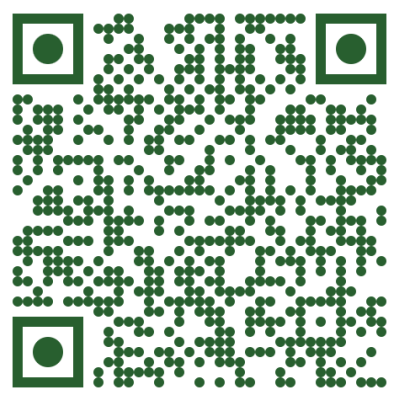


You found a red mulberry!

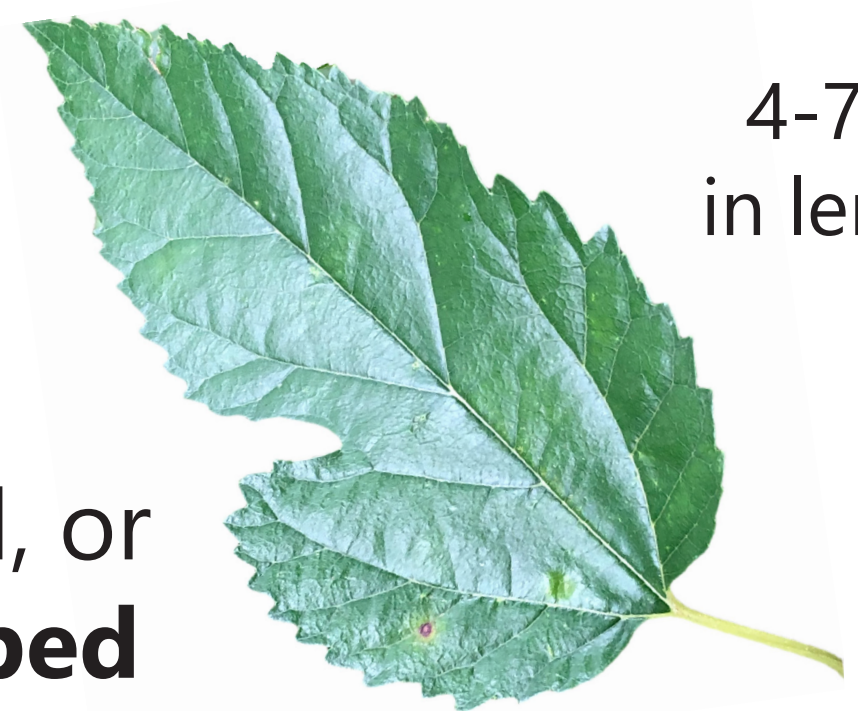
Scientific name: *Morus rubra* L.

Red mulberry is known for its **rough-textured** leaves and **blackberry-like** fruits
